

# Database Connector

The **Live Forms** Database Connector lets you create forms that read from and write to your database. Users can access data from your database using your Live Forms, and if your business rules permit it, use the forms to update or delete the data as well. The connector translates the SQL queries you run against your database into a format your Web browser can understand. Your forms access the connector via a URI that you provide in the Form/flow Designers.

This documentation describes the v2.5.x version of the frevvo database connector.

- frevvo Connectors are an Add on feature with additional costs
- frevvo only supports/certifies the Database Connector running in the Apache Tomcat container. Refer to our Supported Platforms for the list of Application Servers and databases supported/certified by frevvo
